"Oh, I didn't, boss," replies Beckham, "but everybody knows a cuckoo lives in a clock."

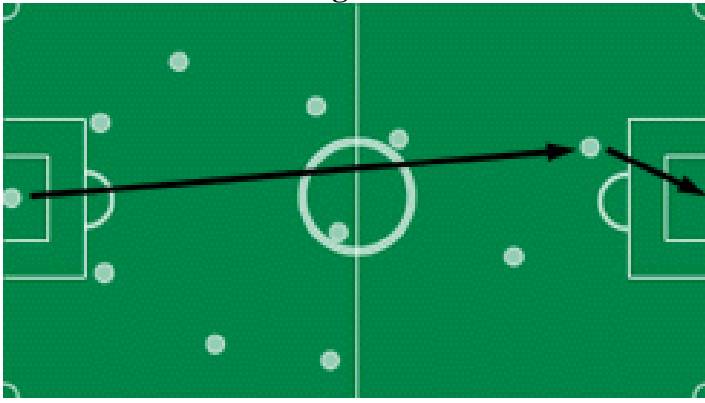
Alex Ferguson walked into the dressing room before a game, looked over to his latest signing and said, "I'm not supposed to let you play since you failed maths, but we need you in there.

The player thought for a moment and then answered, "4?" "Did you say 4?" Alex exclaimed, excited that he had got it right.

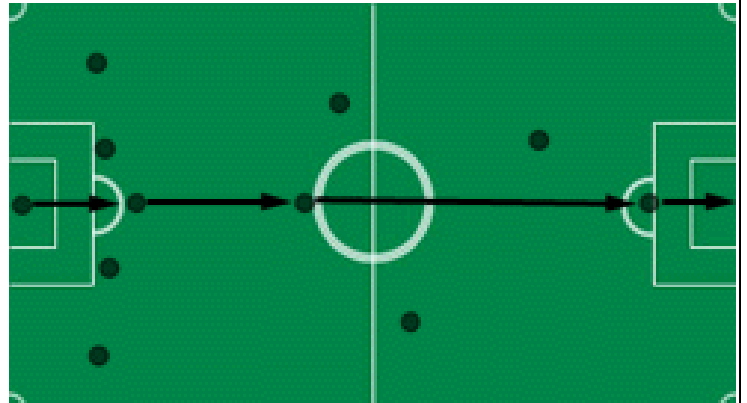
David Beckham then goes up to his manager and whispers in his ear... "Come on Mr Ferguson, give him another chance!"

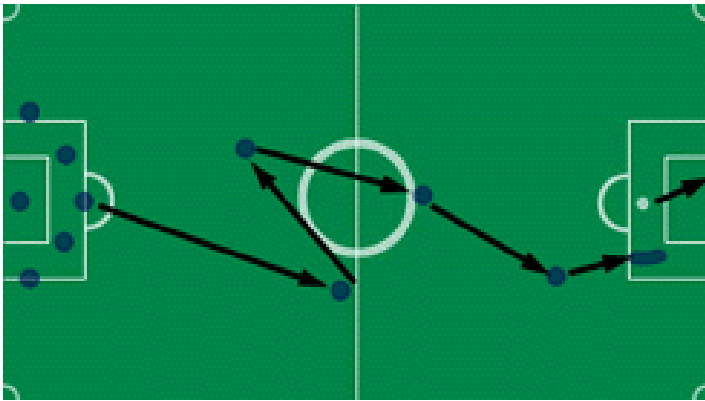
Depending on the wind, the striker's position may vary...

The German Plan



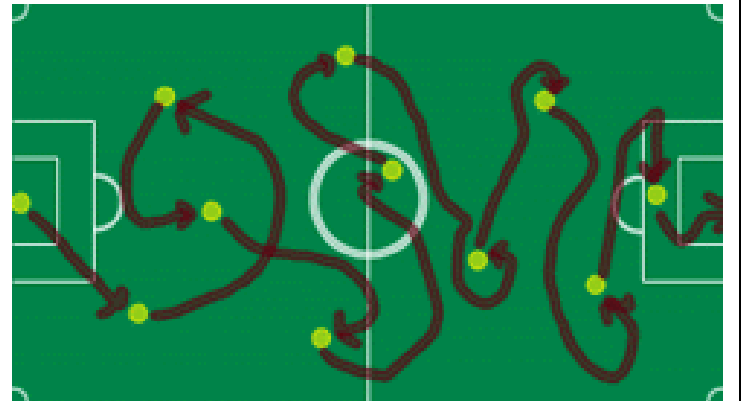
Radical, efficient, unstoppable... (ball's speed may reach 297 km/h)

The Italian Plan



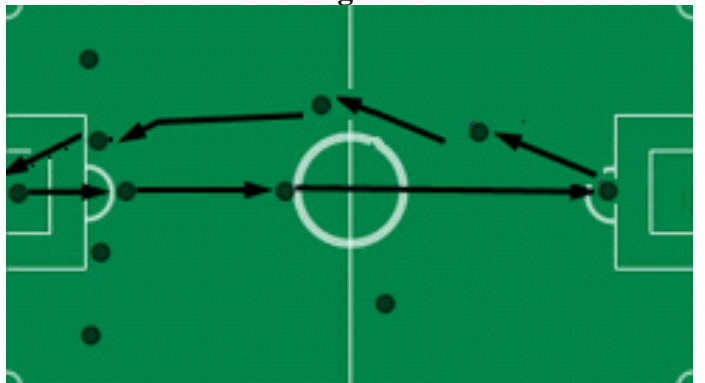
Iron defense, small presence in midfield, passes to striker...and...Penalty

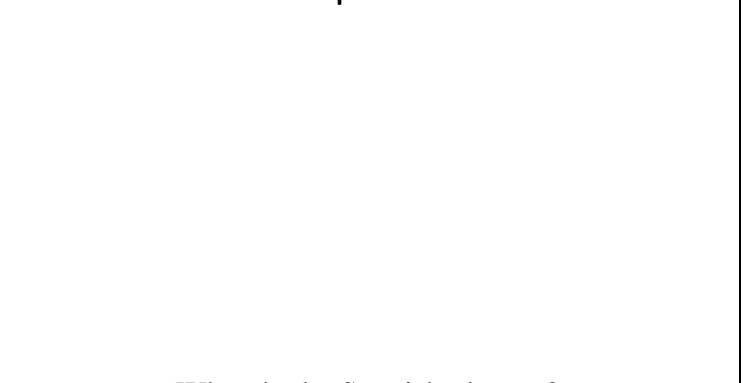

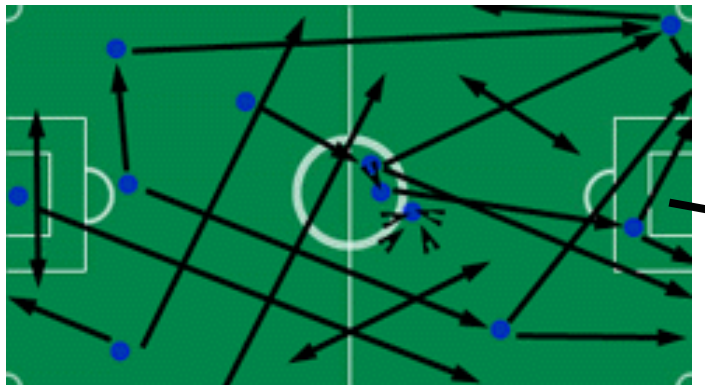

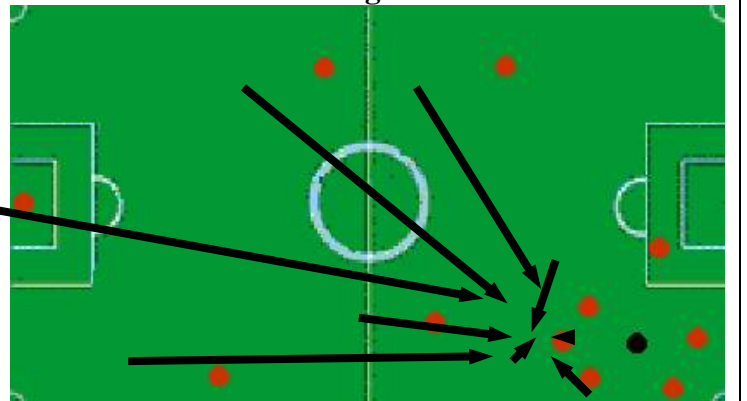
